Heerkens, PMP, CPM, CBM, PE, MBA, is president of Management Solutions Group, a company that provides innovative project management educational solutions and enterprise-wide project management development support. Prior to founding Management Solutions Group, he spent over 20 years managing a variety of project types and sizes for the Eastman Kodak Company.
